2026 Contest Rules and Information

Who can enter?

The Little Miss Apple Scrapple Pageant is open to girls who reside in the Woodbridge School District who are five, six, seven, or eight years old on the day of the contest.

What is the date?

The contest will be held on Friday, October 9th beginning at approximately 6:15pm on the stage behind the Bridgeville Fire Hall. Contestants should arrive by 5:00pm. There will be a short rehearsal and interview with the judges. Contestants should arrive wearing khaki bottoms. A top will be provided for the opening introductions.

What is the Pageant attire?

Each contestant is to supply her own clothing. She will need a party dress and the clothing appropriate for her talent/speech. Outfits should be age-appropriate and modest. When selecting clothing remember that contestants will be changing quickly!

Talent?

Contestant, here's your chance to show off! You will need to prepare either a talent presentation or a reading or speech. Be creative. Your talent/speech may be no longer than ***two (2) minutes and age-appropriate***. Any musical accompaniment media must be submitted in advance.

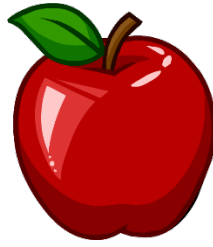
What does it cost?

There is a \$25 registration fee. All proceeds will benefit the Apple Scrapple Festival Scholarship Fund. Make all checks payable to: Apple Scrapple Festival. The registration fee must be included with the application.

How is the Pageant judged?

Judging will be based on the following: interview – 30 points; talent/speech – 30 points; poise/party dress – 30 points; stage presence – 10 points. The interview score will consist of an individual interview prior to the contest and a question on stage during the Pageant.

What else do I need to know?

- Contestants may wear blush and lip gloss. No other make-up may be worn.
- The decision of the judges is final.
- NO VISITORS will be allowed in the dressing area.
- One parent may accompany the child into the dressing area and help them set-up. Arrival and set-up is from 5-5:15pm. At 5:15pm all parents will leave the area. No extensions will be made for late arrivals.
- A female dresser will be assigned to each child. Please make notes for the dresser regarding details of each outfit.
- The winner will be expected to reign over the Festival. In addition, the winner should be at next year's Pageant.
- There will be a limited number of contestants. ***Please register early to avoid disappointment.***
- There will no refunds.
